## TUITION FEES—ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

(Canadian \$) (to August 31, 2011)

*Academic program students usually take a maximum of 15 credits (university programs) or 16 credits (Grade 11 & 12 Foundation programs). The cost per credit (or credit equivalent) is \$425.*

### Overseas applicants

Application fee	\$150
Document assessment & first-time registration fee	\$200
Tuition fee deposit	\$10,200

New international students accepted into academic programs (including academic programs with English preparation) arriving directly from overseas are expected to make a tuition deposit of \$10,200. This deposit is normally non-refundable once the student registers at Columbia College. (Note that this deposit will cover the tuition costs of 24 credits total; students who take more than 24 credits, or the equivalent, in their first two semesters will find that they will be expected to pay additional tuition fees.)

### Local applicants

Application fee	\$150
Tuition fees	\$425/credit

New students accepted into academic programs (including academic programs with English preparation) transferring to the College from another institution in Canada, or students continuing their studies at Columbia College, who require a letter to extend visa or Study Permit are expected to make a tuition deposit of \$3,825. (Note that this deposit will cover the tuition costs of 9 credits total; students who take more than 9 credits, or the equivalent, in their first semester will find that they will be expected to pay additional tuition fees.)

Tuition fees for Grade 11/12 foundation student taking 3 courses, 12 credits	\$5,100
