If the students are at least 17 years old

They may be eligible for our Community College Program without receiving a diploma from their American high school. No TOEFL test required.

1. Enrollment to students that have studied in an American high school for at least 9 months and have reached the age of 17. They do not need to have a regular diploma; any type of completion certificate will be accepted. And TOEFL will not be required.

What is a "Community College"?

A student who is interested in furthering his/her education has two main options in the United States. After high school, the student may enroll in a four-year university to work on a bachelor degree or choose to begin his college experience in a "community college".
